

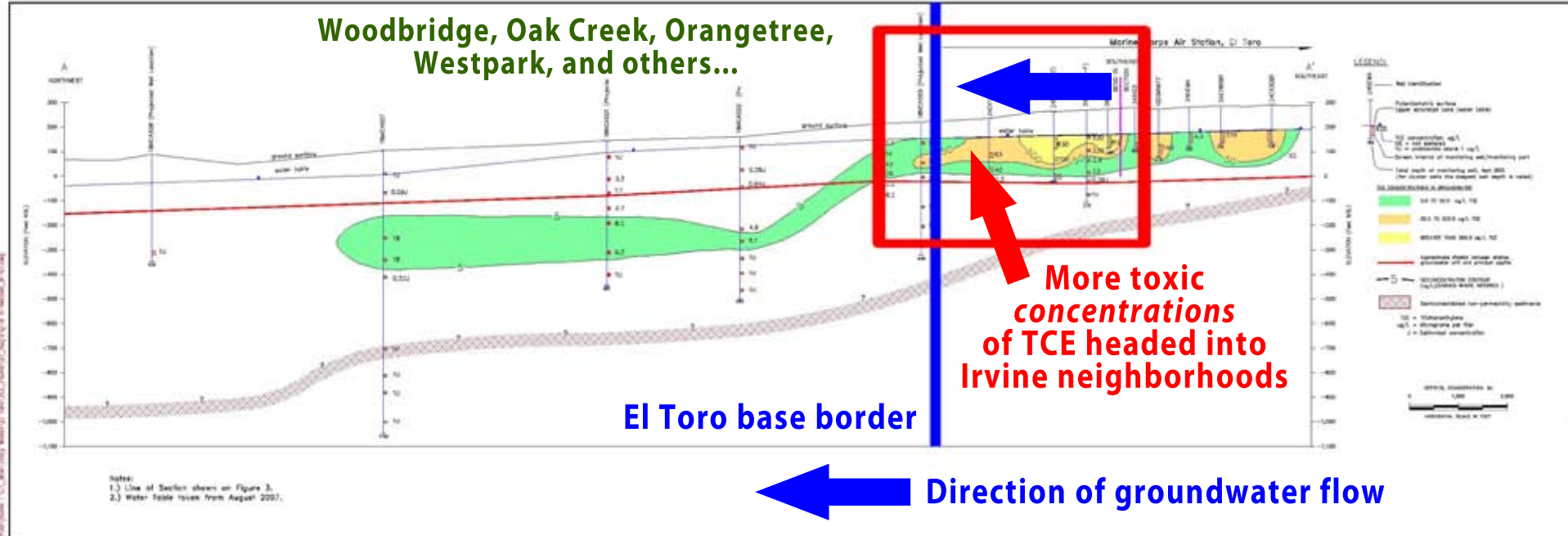

# Warning: More contamination headed towards Irvine neighborhoods

Off El Toro (In Irvine neighborhoods)

More toxic concentrations of TCE headed into Irvine neighborhoods

Direction of groundwater flow

Notice how higher levels of TCE (10-100 times EPA safe level) are migrating off base (see red arrow) into surrounding Irvine neighborhoods. How? The cleanup effort on base, which is stirring the toxic TCE plume, is causing *higher* concentrations of TCE to migrate off El Toro. The result: An even *bigger* water and vapor contamination threat to surrounding Irvine residents, and their property values!
